## **NO TREATED WOOD WASTE BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2021**

New state laws categorize treated wood waste (TWW) as material that can no longer be accepted at county landfill sites. MCRWMA will no longer accept TWW for disposal after December 31, 2020.

### **What is treated wood waste (TWW)?**

TWW is any wood treated with chemical preservatives to protect from insects and decay. This includes, but is not limited to:

**Fence posts • Guardrails • Sill plates • Decking  
Patio wood • Pilings • Railroad ties, and more.**
